The BMX Sarrians track facility features a SX combo track incorporating both an 8mt SX start hill for Championship classes and 5mt start hill for Challenge classes. The SX track is approximately 410mt long.

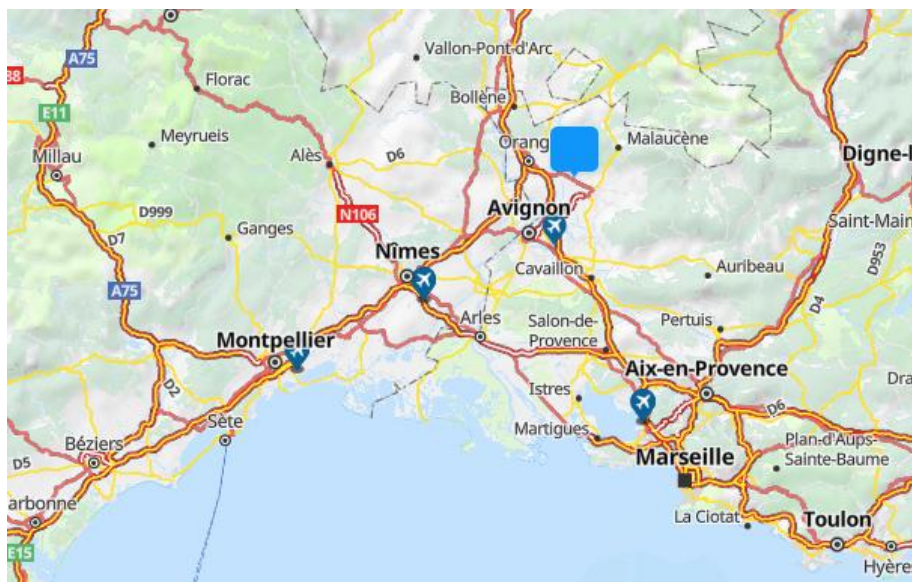

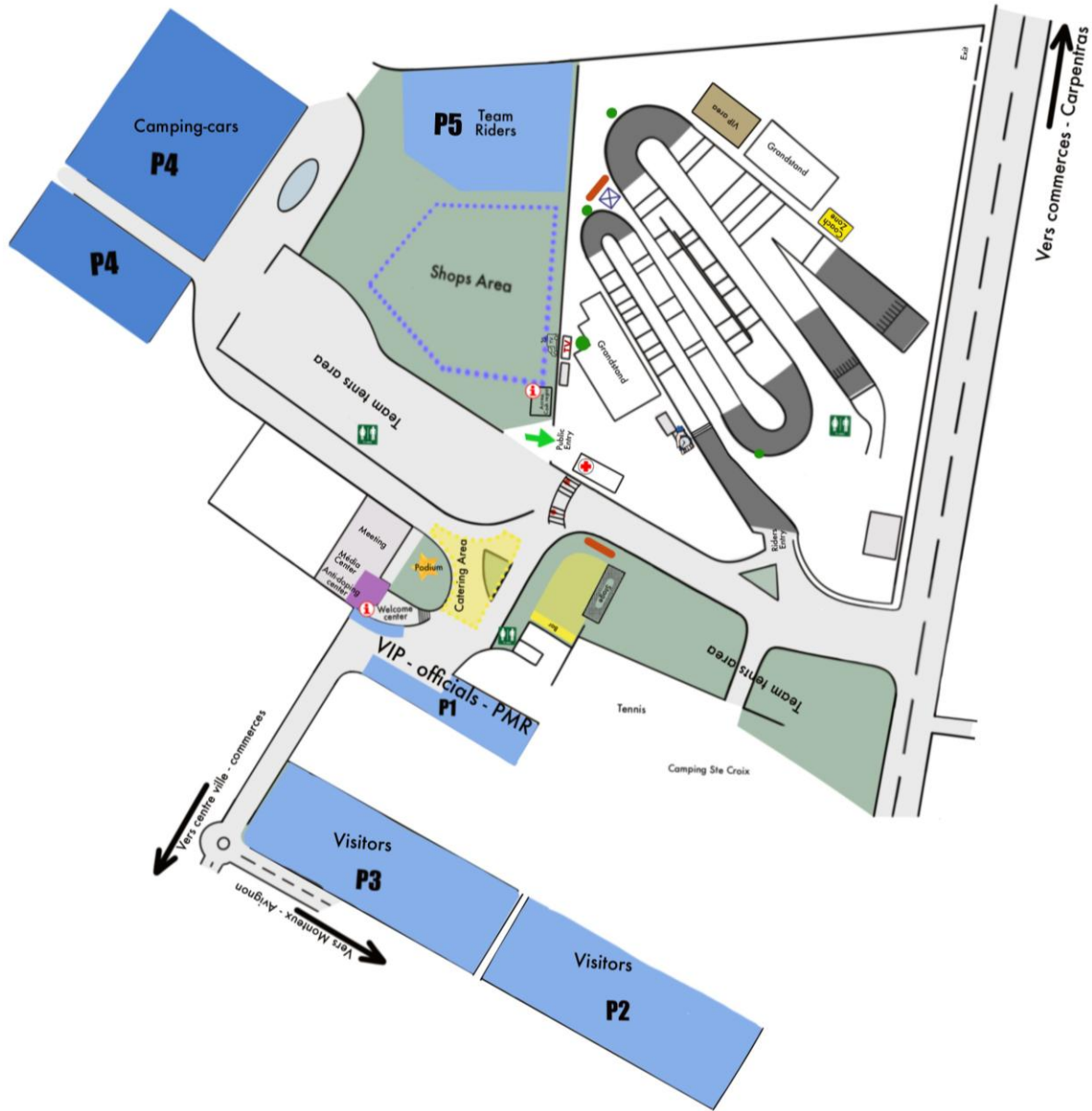

8. RIDER CATEGORIES

In accordance with the UCI rules only European riders can participate in a CC race.
All riders (Challenge and Championship) must hold a national license issued by an UCI affiliated Federation.

In order for a category to be held, at least nine riders must be pre-registered in that category.

If less than nine riders are entered in a challenge category following the cancellation, the category will be combined according to UCI rules.

In the case that any under-subscribed category cannot be combined according to these rules, this category shall not be run. The federations concerned will be informed of the combination class(es) as soon as possible after the registration deadline.

9. REGISTRATION AND RIDER'S CONFIRMATION

Championship classes

Each Federation is allowed to enter a maximum number of 16 riders in each championship classes.

Challenge classes

Each Federation is allowed to enter a maximum number of 16 riders in all challenge classes, for the host country it is allowed to enter 32 riders in all challenge classes.

Registration procedure

- To register for UEC events you need an account using your UCI-ID.
- You can only register for an event by paying the applicable fees directly;
- *Administration fee depends on the agreements with the organiser;
- **If applicable, National Federation fee;
- ***Bank costs depend on your payment choice and will be charged directly;
- After registration you receive a confirmation e-mail from JSTiming;
- In this portal you can find the most current registration overview at the event under the 'Entries' button;
- Cancellation costs and administration/bank costs depend on the agreements with the organiser;
- After cancellation you receive an e-mail confirming your cancellation from JSTiming;
- Refund [if applicable] will follow the deadline for cancellations;
- If assistance is needed, please check [FAQ - Registration JSTiming](#).

Late entries

Late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for late entries, paying double entry fee. The deadline for late entries can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.

Extra late entries

Extra late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for extra late entries, paying triple entry fee. The deadline for extra late entries can also be found on the event page in the registration portal.

Deadline cancellations

The deadline for cancellations can also be found on the event page in the registration portal. In case of a cancellation before the deadline, the entry fee will be refunded. Cancellation fee, administration fee and bank costs (per rider, per category) still must be paid. These fees will be deducted from the paid entry fees.

In case of a cancellation after the deadline, the entry fee will NOT be refunded.

Rider confirmation

All team managers and Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation at the Welcome centre to confirm their riders' participation for the event.

Transponders

All riders in Challenge 15/16 and Championships classes (Junior, U23 and Elite) require a UEC transponder to be able to participate. The transponders are provided by UEC. They will be provided in a bag per country to the Chef d'Equipe / team manager.

Immediately after the race, the transponders for each country must be handed in by the Chef d'Equipe / team manager after the race.

Consequences of non-return of a transponder:

- Your registration account on JSTiming will be blocked.
- Because the transponder cannot be rented out at other events, a fee of €5 per week will be charged for a non-returned transponder.
- In case of non-return, an additional €100 replacement fee will be charged.
- Please return transponders in proper packaging.
- Any import duties and other return costs will also be at your expense.

10. RULES

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI's BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments:

- Rider categories: as set forth in chapter 7.
- The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically results.jstiming.com
- All relevant information/changes during the event will be communicated in the UEC BMX Racing Whatsapp group.
- Number of motos: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate to reduce the number of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

Event format Challenge categories

- For all Challenge categories, excluded Boys 15-16 & Girls 15-16, scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to article 6.1.027quater of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- For a category to be held, at least 13 riders must be registered and confirmed in that category following rider's confirmation. If less than 13 riders are entered in a category following riders' confirmation, the riders will be combined with the category of the same gender, following Article 6.3.005 bis of the UCI Rulebook.

Event format Challenge category Boys 15/16, Girls 15/16 and Championship categories:

- The UCI BMX World Cup system is used according to the latest version of the [UCI BMX Rulebook \(link to UCI website\)](#).
- All riders in the categories 15, 16, Junior, U23 and Elite require a UEC transponder to participate in UEC BMX European Championships.
- Seeding Round 1 Boys & Girls 15-16: on UEC European Cup Ranking
- Seeding Round 1 Jun, U23, Elite: on latest UCI ranking
- Seeding LCQ and qualifiers based on lap times

Rider's equipment

All Challenge riders (including 15/16 riders) must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country.

All riders receive a number plate and side plate from UEC at registration of the UEC BMX European Cup Race. In all UEC sanctioned BMX events a rider must display the number plate and side plate assigned to him. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.

All Championship riders must wear their National Jersey with career number if they have one.

Article 1.3.059: the wearing of National Team clothing shall be mandatory :

- At World Championships
- At Continental Championships
- For the riders of a National team
- During Olympic and Paralympic games, in accordance with the IOC and NOC Regulations.

The Continental and National Champions must comply with these rules and wear their national team clothing while participating in the events cited here before.

Article 1.3.071: Without prejudice to relevant provisions but applicable for all the disciplines, should various provisions requiring the wearing of different jerseys apply to the same rider, the order of priority shall be as follows:

- 1.the leader's jerseys on the stage race
- 2.the world champion's jersey
- 3.the leader's jersey of the cup, series or UCI classification
- 4.the continental champion's jersey
- 5.the national champion's jersey
- 6.the national jersey

In accordance with the last amendments of the UCI rules the World Champions must wear their rainbow jersey.

In case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate can make changes to the time schedule.

Please note: In the event the European Championships cannot take place for unpredictable circumstances (weather conditions, pandemic, etc.), the UEC cannot be responsible. Therefore, registration fees cannot be refunded.

Team manager meeting

Team Managers meeting will be held as indicated in the time schedule. The location of the meeting will be indicated at the event. The participation is mandatory for: max. 1 National Delegate (Chef d'Equipe); max. 1 Team Manager of the UEC registered team; max. 1 Team manager of UCI registered team, max. 2 National BMX Coaches (registered by National federation).

If necessary, the UEC Technical delegate and PCP can decide to call for other meetings during the event.



11. ACCREDITATION

Athletes

All athletes will be given a wristband so that they can reach all areas necessary.

Chef d'Equipe

Each federation that pre-registers riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (national team manager) to represent the interests of all its riders. Each Chef d'Equipe must confirm the presence of each rider as per the pre-registration riders list at rider confirmation, as indicated in the timing schedule.

A Chef d'Equipe and his nominated staff is accredited by the UEC with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

Mandatory registration of staff before the event

Prior to each event, it is mandatory for every national federation to register their appointed Chef d'Equipe as well as the entire team. Federations are required to submit the names of all staff members via email to j.polkamp@uec.ch in advance of the event. **Deadline: 19 June 2026.**

Chef d'Equipe, Team managers and assistants must present a license issued by the federation. The UEC will verify the registration details of all staff members before granting accreditation. Please note that accreditation will not be issued by the UEC in the absence of proper registration.

National Teams

Prior to each event, it is mandatory for every national federation to register their National team staff (Championship coach, doctor, other staff members). Federations are required to submit the names and the roles of all staff members via email to j.polkamp@uec.ch in advance of the event.

Deadline: 19 June 2026.

UEC Teams

2026 UEC BMX Teams do **NOT** receive accreditation for the UEC BMX European Championships.

Personal BMX coaches for Championship riders

Championships riders who come to the event with a personal BMX coach are offered the possibility to buy a Coach accreditation. This allows you access to the team manager meeting and coach area.

This accreditation (for Championships riders only) costs €150 per weekend (cash only).

Coach accreditation can be bought from UEC at the Welcome Centre during rider confirmation.

12. PRIZE MONEY , MEDALS, JERSEY AND TROPHIES

The winner of the Championship categories (mentioned above) receive an official UEC Championships jersey and a gold medal. Number 2 and 3 receive a silver and bronze medals.

Price money will be awarded according to the price money schedule below, The UEC will proceed to the payment on the price money by the middle of October 2026 through the riders' National Cycling Federation.

Podium ceremony

Only Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obligated to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bikes, for media purposes. Afterwards riders may take photos with commercial items.

Challenge Categories

Trophies are available for the finalists of all classes of the Continental Championship race for Challenge classes. Trophies place 4th to 8th place in the final will be awarded immediately at the finish line. Challenge riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obliged to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bike, for media purposes.

17. LIVESTREAM

The UEC BMX European Challenge events are broadcasted live on UEC website: www.uec.ch.

The UEC BMX European Championships events are broadcasted live by EUROVISION. TV takers are available one week before the event on UEC website.

18. PARKING

A free parking place with ample capacity is situated next to the track for team managers, officials and shops (entry with pass). At a walking distance of about 300 metres there is a second free, amply parking space for riders and visitors.

19. CATERING

There will be several catering stands, where you can buy hot and cold food and drinks.

20. SHOPS

A BMX Village will be set up during the UEC BMX European Championships and Challenge. If you would like your shop or entertainment to be present during the event, please send an e-mail to contact@bmx-sarrians.fr to reserve your space in the BMX Village or ask for more information.

21. PRESS

Throughout the event there will be a dedicated work area for journalists and general press in the sports arena on the track area. Riders can be interviewed from this location. The location of the press centre can be found on the venue map.

Press accreditation for the event may be granted only to accredited journalists in possession of an ID card issued by the national press association. Accreditation for the events must be done through the UEC website for all UEC events <http://uec.ch/en/media>.
Deadline Press Accreditation 17 June 2026.

During the UEC BMX European Championships events Press accreditation and BIB's will be handed out by UEC Press Officer / deputy. It's mandatory to wear UEC press BIB's for the journalists on the track. The UEC will provide them and have someone responsible for their distribution.

The number of journalists on the track at the same time must be agreed by the PCP depending on the track space/size.

Press conferences, flash interviews etc. must be agreed with the UEC BMX Commission.

For all publications the UEC logo as well as the UEC main sponsor logo should be used in accordance with UEC graphic charter.

General rules

- At every UEC BMX event BIB's are used for press on and off the track.
- The distribution of the BIB at the events is done by the indicated UEC press officer or his / her deputy.
- During the events, five red Bibs' (of which one for the UEC photographer) are distributed, the rest of the photographers get a yellow BIB.
- The BIB distribution is examined separately for Challenge and Championship classes
- A guarantee for each BIB is mandatory: € 20 or an official document (driver's license, identity card, press card ...)
- By failing to comply with the regulations or the instructions of officials, the BIB can be taken from a photographer immediately.
- Be careful when using flash. Do not flash directly into the eyes of the riders.
- Photographers must be impartial on the track; it is not allowed to cheer for a rider in the track.

- It is strictly forbidden to touch a rider and / or bicycle.
- It's forbidden to walk across the photo finish line. This can cause problems for the people of the photo finish cameras.
- A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.

Drones

- Drones might be allowed after consultation with the UEC responsible, providing they are allowed by local laws. The pilot must hold a valid pilot license and there must be compliance with all regulations regarding the airline (flight plan etc.) Moreover, the minimum and the maximum height are fixed according to the regulations of the country. Failure to comply with all the proposed rules will be reported to the police.

22. MEDICAL INFORMATION

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout practice and racing. The team will be based on the track and have use of a medical room near staging area.

The medical team will be available at the following times:
